#### **Eligibility Requirements**

- I. The applicant must be a resident of Seymour, Connecticut.
- II. The applicant must be pursuing an education in the environmental field or related studies.

#### **APPLICATION Program**

- I. <u>Applications will be available at the guidance office of Seymour High, the town hall and the town library.</u>
- II. The winner will be chosen by the executive committee of the Seymour Land Conservation Trust with the recommendations from the guidance office of the Seymour High School.
- III. The winner of the award will be presented with \$500.00 at the annual Seymour High School awards banquet although the winner does not have to be graduating from Seymour High School (state and private school students are eligible).
- IV. Presently, the scholarship is funded for ten(10) years with \$500.00 each year and we hope to be able to increase this amount in the later years.
- V. All applications must be received by May 1<sup>st</sup>.
